

## Wild Life Sculpture Search

Discover six sculpture installations ● along the West Loop of the Boardwalk at Boca Ciega Millennium Park, a Pinellas County Park. All sculptures are placed within the natural areas, some sculptures are obvious and some are placed discreetly in the midst of nature.



The six installations were premiered at the park on March 3, 2007. The plaster sculptures will continue to inhabit the park for months to come. Artist Leslie Fry integrates two different worlds within her sculptures, the human aspect of urban development and the natural world as seen at Boca Ciega Millennium Park. We hope you continue to enjoy the sculptures as they take on different characteristics and change over time. Please treat the sculptures with the same respect as the rest of the precious plant and animal life here.
